**The Dance**

**Baile folklórico**, literally "folk dance" in Spanish, is a collective term for traditional Latin American dances that emphasize local folk culture. Each region in Mexico, the Southwestern United States and Central American countries is known for a handful of locally characteristic dances. *Tradiciones de Oro* will feature many of these dances presented in their traditional style and dress.

### The Music

Mariachi music, as we know it today, results from the confluence of several different influences: European styled concert ensembles on haciendas composed of violins, harp, guitars, jawharps and other instruments, simpler coastal folk ensembles whose African influence gives mariachi some of its key rhythmic elements, and the harp and violin ensembles of the *tierra caliente*.
